1. North Sewer Treatment Plant Upgrades – Project Completed; Council to authorize Final Payment Request to be submitted to Facility Planning
2. Sewer Phase VII LCDBG (Terrebonne & Delgrandile)- Construction has begun; contract term is 180 days estimated to be end of 4th quarter of 2024 but likely extended due to delay in material
3. Mitigation Project (Seawall) – GOHSEP and FEMA did not approve; SCPDC is applying through Delta Regional Authority and GIS is working on capital outlay request for the matching funds of the DRA application
4. Infrastructure Grant applications (FMA Grant) (Jefferson Street Drainage, Oakridge Park Drainage, Dursette/Pershing Area Drainage) – GIS contract executed and engineering work to begin
5. Clean Water State Revolving Fund (Sewer Phase VIII (8)) (Cheremie) – Requesting servitude signatures – 1 remaining
6. Capital Outlay – Replacement of Sewer Lift Station behind Williams Road- Notice to Proceed issued for 9.30.24 with estimated completion date of 3.29.25 but likely extended due to delay in material
7. Capital Outlay – Armand/Alcide Area Drainage, Planning and Construction; GIS estimating to go out for bid advertising in the middle of December 2024
8. New Capital Outlay Requests for FY 25-26 was submitted **10.30.24** for the following projects: Floodwall Upgrades, Extension of Maintenance Building, Martinez Lane Drainage, Cleanout of Existing Drainage Structures, Armand/Alcide Area Drainage, Replacement of Sewer Lift Station behind Williams Road
