The Mayor and Council of the Town of Golden Meadow met for their regular scheduled meeting on Monday, February 4, 2013 at 7:00 P.M. at the Town Hall, 107 Jervis Drive, Golden Meadow, LA 70357.

Mayor Joey Bouziga called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Councilman Priscilla Mounic presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cheramie seconded approving the minutes from the Council meeting held on January 22, 2013. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman David Adams led everyone in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Jody Cheramie led everyone in prayer.

Mayor Joey Bouziga informed the Council no building permit applications were submitted for approval.

Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Willis Toups seconded approving an Occupational License for A.N.A. Handy Man owner Albert Rendon, 138 Pelican Lane. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga presented the clean-up report as follows:

- Ed Diaz Office – South Bayou Drive was sent a clean-up letter on January 17, 2013.

Mayor Bouziga presented the dangerous building report as follows:

- Louis Adam Griffin – 143 Griffin Lane, a report will be presented at the next meeting.
- Lloyd Ledet, Jr. – 120 Meadow Lane is being inspected by the building inspector. A report will be presented at the next Council meeting.
- Steve and Nancy Cheramie – 128 Meadow Lane is being inspected by the building inspector. A report will be presented at the next Council meeting.
- Lloyd Ledet, Jr. - 133 Meadow Lane is being inspected by the building inspector. A report will be presented at the next Council meeting.

Mayor Joey Bouziga presented a parade permit for the Krewe of Nereids on Sunday, March 2, 2013. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Willis Toups seconded approving this item be deferred until the next Council meeting. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Bouziga requested adding the Krewe of Neptune parade permit to the agenda. No audience comments were presented. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman David Adams seconded approving aforesaid be added to the agenda. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman Willis Toups presented a motion and Councilman David Adams seconded approving a discussion take place regarding the Krewe of Neptune parade permit. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented. Councilman briefly discussed the conduct of riders in the Krewe of Neptune. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Willis Toups seconded approving the Krewe of Neptune parade permit and authorized Mayor Joey Bouziga and Chief Reggie Pitre meet with riders to discuss their conduct and choice of music. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Engineer John Plaisance presented the project report as follows:

- Sewer Phase III is under construction.
- Sewer Phase IV is undergoing right-of-way research and bids should be advertised in April or May.
- Seawall Phase II – FEMA awarded an additional \$400,000.00 to this project. We are waiting on the official award letter.
- Seawall Phase III – Planning stages.
- Oakridge Park Waterline Phase I and Phase II is complete.
- Oakridge Park Waterline Phase III - An application has been submitted for funding in the amount of \$35,000.00.
- Frank's Supermarket crossover has been approved. Funds have been requested for the Bonding Commission.
- An application has been submitted for the installation of a crossover to be installed in front of the Town Hall.
- Fuel System – Planning stages.
- Basketball Pavilion – This project is in planning stages and is being funded by the Lafourche Parish Government.
- Emergency equipment shelter and additional parking project has been awarded through the Lafourche Parish Government.
- Street Resurfacing Project – Contractor have not returned to town to complete the shoulders of the streets.

Mayor Joey Bouziga presented the Council with an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Golden Meadow Police Department and the Lockport Police Department for additional officers for Mardi Gras. After a brief discussion Councilman Willis Toups presented a motion and Councilman David Adams seconded declining the Police Department enter in the agreement. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

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Mayor Joey Bouziga presented the 2012 4th quarter finance report.

Councilman Priscilla Mounic presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cheramie seconded authorizing Mayor Joey Bouziga enters into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the Lafourche Parish Government for Transportation Funds. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga requested adding a loud music permit for Barrios Seafood to the agenda. No audience comments were presented. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving aforesaid be added to the agenda. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Willis Toups seconded approving a loud music permit for Barrios Seafood on Sunday, February 10, 2013 at 9:00 P.M. through Monday, February 11, 2013 at 2:00 A.M. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga requested audience comments.

Mr. Jac Culver addressed the Council regarding Entergy installing a very large power line along Hwy. 308. Mr. Culver presented plans and maps of the new lines. After a brief discussion Councilman Willis Toups presented a motion and Councilman David Adams seconded approving Resolution No. 1542 in opposition of the current location to construct a large power line and requesting the power line be installed further into the marsh. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

With no further business to discuss Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cheramie seconded approving this meeting adjourns at 7:48 P.M. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.
