The Mayor and Council of the Town of Golden Meadow met for their regular scheduled meeting on Monday, November 3, 2014 at 7:00 P.M. at the Town Hall, 107 Jervis Drive, Golden Meadow, LA 70357.

Mayor Joey Bouziga called this meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Councilman David Adams led everyone in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance and Councilman Jody Cheramie led everyone in prayer.

Councilman Willis Toups presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving the minutes from the previous meeting held on Monday, October 20, 2014. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga informed the Council no building permits were submitted for approval.

Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cheramie seconded approving an Occupational License for Off the Bone 704 N Alex Plaisance Blvd. owner Ricky Vauhan. The Councilman unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman Willis Toups presented a motion and Councilman David Adams seconded approving an Occupational License for Choice Security Services, LLC located at 187 B. & R. Lane owners Beverly St. Pierre and Karen Griffin. The Councilman unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga presented the clean-up report as follows:

- Ashley Adams – 505 C N Bayou Drive has a deadline of November 10, 2014.
- Gloria Bouzigard – 112 Delgrandile Lane has been sent a clean-up letter.

Mayor Joey Bouziga presented the dangerous building report as follows:

- Dinah Stallings – 508 S Bayou Drive will be re-inspected by Building Officials and a report will be made at the next meeting.
- Roy Borne – will be inspected by the Building Officials and a report will be presented at the next meeting.

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Mayor Joey Bouziga informed the Council the two abandoned vehicles located on N 1st Street have not been removed. Councilman Willis Toups presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving Chief Reggie Pitre have the vehicles towed at no expense to the Town. The Councilman unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga informed the Council the project report will be presented once Engineer John Plaisance arrives at the meeting.

Attorney Bryce Autin presented the legal report as follows:

- The revised Sewer Ordinance is ready to discuss at a Public Hearing on Monday, November 17, 2014. Councilman Priscilla Mounic presented a motion and Councilman David Adams seconded approving a Public Hearing on Monday, November 17, 2014 at 6:30 P.M. The Councilman unanimously approved the motion as presented.
- Unpaid clean-ups will be discussed with Archon for collection.
- Unpaid sewer bills will be discussed at a later date.
- Lease Agreement with the Lafourche Parish Government has been turned over to the Lafourche Parish Government for review.
- At the last meeting anonymous complaints were discussed. After review of Town Ordinances Attorney Bryce Autin suggested adding anonymous complaints be added to the Clean-up Ordinance. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cherie seconded approving a Public Hearing be scheduled on Monday, November 17, 2014 at 6:45 P.M. to discuss amending the Ordinance pertaining to anonymous complaints. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Engineer John Plaisance presented the project report as follows:

- North Plant Sewer Upgrades plans continue to progress.
- Sewer Phase IV remains in the right-of-way stages.
- Sewer Phase V has submitted an application for funding.
- Seawall Phase II continues to work on reimbursement from GOSEPH.
- Seawall Phase I Repairs are progressing.
- Seawall Phase III remains in the planning stages.
- Fuel System Canopy is in the planning stages.
- T.H. Turnaround paperwork has been completed and is in the planning stages.
- Lift Station replacement have submitted a capital outlay application for funding.

Mayor Joey Bouziga informed the Council the Town only received one sealed bid for the purchase of the old fuel tanks. The bid was submitted by D Company in the amount of \$377.00. After a brief discussion Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cherie seconded rejecting the bid. Councilman Willis Toups presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving the Clerk re-

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advertise for sealed bids for the sale of the two fuel tanks with fuel dispenser. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman Priscilla Mounic presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cheramie seconded authorizing Mayor Joey Bouziga execute a Memorandum of Agreement for Multi-Jurisdictional Planning Team with the Lafourche Parish Government. The Councilman unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman Priscilla Mounic presented a motion and Councilman Willis Toups seconded approving Councilmen be given a copy of a letter of request from Entergy to be reviewed and voted on at the next meeting. The Councilman unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving a parade permit for the Veteran's Day Parade on Friday November 14, 2014. The Councilman unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga presented several complaints as follows:

- A complaint was received regarding tall grass and cleaning needed at 129 Terrebonne Lane. Councilman Priscilla Mounic presented a motion and Councilman David Adams seconded approving a tall grass and clean-up letter be sent to the property owner. The Councilman unanimously approved the motion as presented.
- A complaint was received regarding an accumulation of trash at 2217 N Bayou Drive. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Jody Cheramie seconded approving a clean-up letter be sent to the property owner. The Councilman unanimously approved the motion as presented.
- A complaint was received regarding two abandoned vehicles at 140 Pierce Street. Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman Lindberg Lorraine seconded approving the vehicles be tagged and a public nuisance letter be sent to the owner. The Councilman unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga requested adding a complaint of termites and Christmas Parade to the agenda. No audience comments were presented in objection. Councilman Jody Cheramie presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded approving Mayor Joey Bouziga add the aforesaid to the agenda. The Councilman unanimously approved the motion as presented.

Mayor Joey Bouziga informed the Council he received a complaint from Ms. Alice Terrebonne regarding a tree in an abandoned house with termites. After a brief discussion, Councilman David Adams presented a motion and Councilman David Adams seconded approving the office research the bank who owns the property and send a letter requesting the tree be removed. The Councilman unanimously approved the motion as presented.

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Mayor Joey Bouziga informed the Council a Christmas Parade will be held on Saturday, November 29, 2014 at 4:00 P.M.

Mayor Joey Bouziga requested audience comments.

Ms. Wendy Thibodaux addressed the Council regarding the November 4, 2014 election.

With no further business to discuss Councilman Willis Toups presented a motion and Councilman Priscilla Mounic seconded adjourning this meeting at 7:33 P.M. The Councilman unanimously approved the motion as presented.
