Mayor Joey Bouziga called the Public Hearing to order at 6:30 P.M.

Mayor Joey Bouziga requested comments or questions regarding the amendment of Ordinance No. 451 reducing the curfew during daylight savings time/winter months due to recent vandalism and petty thefts.

Mr. Lloyd Ledet suggested the curfew be enforced approximately three hours after daylight. Chief Pitre presented statistics from January 1, 2019 of suspicious people walking the streets a night, one leading to an arrest. Councilman discussed the possibility of changing the curfew from 8:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M.

With no further business to discuss, Councilman Laci Latiolais presented a motion and Councilman Willis Toups seconded adjourning this hearing at 6:43 P.M. The Council unanimously approved the motion as presented.
